(b) Write a report for a cultural magazine about the visit of the Minister of Education on the occasion of the last prize-giving ceremony at your school.

(c) You were absent from school for several days. Write a dialogue between you and your teacher who is inquiring about the matter. [15]

2 From the topics listed below, write **one** essay of about **200** words in **Arabic**. It will be to your advantage to keep to the recommended length.

(a) While you were watching TV last night, you heard a loud noise near your house. Narrate what happened next.

(b) Your parents attended a dinner party last week so you were alone at home. Describe what you did during their absence.

(c) Describe the village or the town where you spent your childhood.

(d) "Nowadays, women have become very liberated." Do you agree?
